This is the only remaining example of a G.S. class wagon. When built its design was technically innovative and was the forerunner of WAGR "modern" 4 wheel wagons of which many were built (classified by the National Trust 12/10/98)

Back in the 30's – 40's these A Class Steam Locos from the Midland WAGR Yard were the grain movers of the day. Wyalkatchem Museum has a Heritage listed 1941 GS Rail Wagon as used for wheat transport in our region. (Donated by WAGR and Heritage listed 5028).
